Presentation Breakdown:	Suggested Time:
Transition & Set-Up	5 Minutes
Be sure to have <u>your</u> laptop (with your presentation) ready to hook up to	
our projection and sound. If needed, our room facilitator will assist you	
with the set-up of your laptop.	
Introduction	1 Minute
Introduce yourself to the audience. Share some of your background.	
Research Topic & Why Important	2 Minutes
What is your topic? Explain why you researched it. Why was it	
important to you? Who else will benefit from your study?	
Background/Literature Review	2 Minutes
In usable terms, what did you have to look at to fully understand your	
topic?	
Methodology	5 Minutes
Share the "3 W's". $\underline{W}$ hat did you do, with $\underline{w}$ hom, and $\underline{w}$ here?	
Findings	5 Minutes
Share your findings but don't overload the audience with too many	
graphs and statistics. Find a valuable balance.	
Discussion with emphasis on Usability & Applicability	5 Minutes
Be sure to share what your research means for the profession. The	
audience will consider it a bonus if you can generalize your information	
to the multiple professions attending (business, behavioral sciences,	
education).	
Question & Answer	5 Minutes

All presentations will be held to a 30-minute maximum (including transition time). The above are recommendations only.
